Across these disparate venues, they have provided a hub for academics to not simply analyze the issues but also directly engage the policy process.”

The commonality of beliefs regarding access to information that exists between PIJIP and Google creates a natural opportunity for partnership between the two institutions. For the past two years PIJIP has been the grateful recipient of philanthropic support from Google. Through Google’s two \$200,000 gifts the program has been able to grow their research and advocacy efforts with a particular emphasis on open access and digital sharing. According to Professor Michael Carroll, Director of PIJIP, “Google’s support has substantially enhanced the ability of PIJIP faculty and staff to conduct or to coordinate research on international intellectual property enforcement and on policies that would promote the public interest in intellectual property law. These resources have been crucial to advancing both the legal discourse and public awareness about the impact of intellectual property lawmaking in both domestic and international arenas.” The faculty and staff at PIJIP look forward to a mutually beneficial relationship with Google for years to come.
