I. Electronic Sources

A. Research Guides

1. "International Commercial Arbitration" www.asil.org/resource/arb1.htm. Located on the American Society of International Law's web site this guide to electronic resources in the this area is comprehensive and complete. Links are provided to the UNCITRAL web site, the ICC, the ICA, PCA as well as other international and regional institutions.

"International Commercial Arbitration: Locating the Resources-Revised" llrx.com/features/arbitration2.htm. and "A Selective Guide to Online International Arbitration Resources." www.llrx.com/features/intarbitration.htm. Located on the Law Library Resource Xchange, a site that provides current awareness materials on legal technology and research issues, these are two of a number of foreign and international law research guides. The first was last updated in May, 2004 while the second was updated in June of that year. The first guide includes reference to print as well as electronic sources and, as such, is more useful.

B. Databases

1. Kluwer Arbitration Online

A subscription database from the legal publisher Kluwer, this source provides access to primary and secondary material in this field. To reach this database from the Pence law library homepage:

Where is the arbitration material in the Pence Law Library:

Arbitration material is generally classified in two call number ranges K 2400 (international commercial arbitration); KF 9085 (international arbitration in the United States).
