Reciprocity:

Remember that NALP member schools agree to provide providing job search assistance to **third-year law students** and **alumni** of other schools through reciprocity. This policy provides that member law schools grant reasonable access to their career-related resources for third-year law students and graduates of other law schools that agree to provide similar services. Please note: most law schools designate a time period when reciprocity requests will not be granted. This usually occurs from August 1 to December 15 when law schools are busy with on-campus recruitment programs.
