

Mary Siegel is professor of law, specializing in Business Law. She teaches Business Associations, Securities Regulation, Mergers, Advanced Securities Law and Advanced Corporate Law. She was one of 24 corporate lawyers appointed to the ABA Committee on Corporate Laws, the sole jurisdiction over the Model Business Corporations Act. She has served as vice chair of the ABA's Business and Corporate Litigation Committee. She is author of many articles on business law in the Columbia Law Review, the University of Pennsylvania Law Review, Harvard Journal on Legislation, the Hastings Law Journal and others. Siegel received WCL's award for Outstanding Scholarship, Research and Other Professional Contributions in 1980; AU's Outstanding Teacher-Scholar Award in 1985; AU's Faculty Award for Outstanding Scholarship Research and Other Professional Contributions in 1986.
