

## **The Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 Time Line of Requirements**

**WHO:** *Bureau of Justice Statistics*

### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMEFRAMES:**

1. Complete a comprehensive statistical review and analysis of incidents and effects of prison rape/ Each Year, through 2010
2. Solicit views from DOC Representatives
3. Prison Rape Review Panel to hold public hearings/ through 2010
4. AG report on activities of the BJS/ June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year through 2010

**WHO:** *The National Institute of Corrections*

### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMEFRAMES:**

1. Establishment of a National Clearinghouse
2. Training and education on prison rape
3. Report to Congress to summarize the DOJ activities for the preceding calendar year/ September 30 through 2010

**WHO:** *Attorney General*

### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMEFRAMES:**

1. AG report on activities of the BJS/ June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year through 2010
2. Grants to states 40,000,000 per fiscal year/ thorough 2010
3. Ensure grantees submit reports on activities carried out under the grant/ 90 days after the termination of the grant
4. Make all grantee reports available nationally through the National Clearinghouse
5. Publish a final rule/ one year after the commission publishes its report
6. Transmit final rule to states and jurisdictions/ 90 days after rule is published
7. Publish a list of all grantees which are not in compliance with national standards/ September 30 of each year

**WHO:** *National Prison Rape Reduction Commission*

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMEFRAMES:**

1. Appointments to the commission/ 60 days after enactment
2. Vacancies filled for the commission/ no later than 60 days after the vacancy occurs
3. Chairperson of the commission appointed/ no more than 15 days after the commission membership is set
4. Initial meeting of the commission/ must be 30 days after the initial appointment of the members is complete
5. Submit a report on the studies carried out under this act/ No more than two years after the initial commission meeting

**WHO:** *Facilities* (in order to receive federal funding)

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMEFRAMES:**

1. Accreditation/ 90 days after enactment
2. Facility must meet standards of rape detection, prevention etc/ at all times after one year post publication of national standards
