

THE FIRST ANNUAL LL.M. EXECUTIVE BOARD AWARD

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this scholarship will be both to award excellence and to facilitate the living experience of LL.M. students, currently enrolled in the International Legal Studies Program, in a city such as Washington DC.

The scholarship is linked to a writing/oral competition based on a legal dispute. Applicants must write a decision resolving the dispute in one of the international mechanisms involved in this case (resolution). The submitted applications are judged by a panel of distinguished experts and the authors of the three (3) best resolutions must orally defend their resolutions before this panel. Applicants are required to do additional research for the resolution.

The amount of the award is **\$1,000.00** funded by the LL.M. Executive Board, and will be credited to the student's AU account toward tuition cost.

ELIGIBILITY:

You are eligible to apply for the scholarship if:

- You are currently enrolled as a student in the International Legal Studies Program.
- Members of the LL.M. Executive Board in office during the competition are not eligible to apply.

FORMAT REQUIREMENTS:

Application must include Name, AU Identification Number, Date of Birth, Nationality, Email Address, Resume and Brief Cover Letter explaining the reasons to apply for this scholarship.

Your resolution must fulfill the following criteria:

- 15 pages in length; not including front page, index and bibliography;
- The front page must include your name, student ID and date of expected graduation;
- Times New Roman font size 12;
- Double spaced;
- 1 cm margins;
- Citations according to the bluebook format.

The deadline for the submission of the written resolutions is **APRIL 13 2007 AT 5 P.M.**

Resolutions must be submitted in hardcopy (6 copies) to a member of the LL.M. Board at the LL.M. Board Office at the 6th floor in the International Student Lounge.
