A Case for Regulating Cyberpayments

This Article asserts that new regulations are needed to allow cyberpayments to compete with existing retail payment systems. The author argues that at a minimum, cyberpayments must be regulated by the same consumer protection regulations that are available for analogous, existing payment systems. The author also recommends regulations created specifically for cyberpayment systems in order to foster consumer acceptance of the new payment systems.
