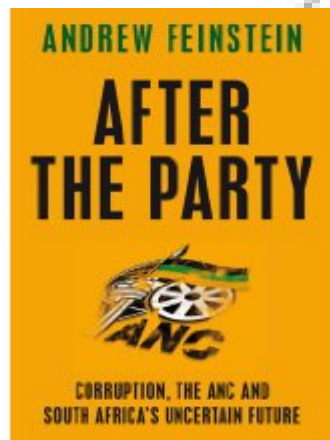

Andrew Feinstein was an ANC Member of Parliament in South Africa for 8 years. He resigned from Parliament in late 2001 in protest of the ANC's refusal to allow an unfettered investigation into a multi-billion rand arms deal that was tainted by allegations of high-level corruption. Mr. Feinstein currently chairs the U.K.-based Friends of the Treatment Action Campaign, an organization that campaigns for the rights of people with HIV and AIDS.
