

APPLICATION FOR LAW AND GOVERNMENT SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The LL.M. Program on Law and Government of American University Washington College of Law announces the establishment of a special Scholars Award for LL.M. candidates with outstanding academic and professional records. Candidates should use this form to apply for this honor. The committee will also review a candidate's transcript, letters of recommendation, and other materials submitted as part of the admissions process.

The Scholars Awards are for LL.M. candidates with excellent academic credentials, especially in courses and seminars related to American public law. In addition, a scholar should have superior references. In addition to completing this form, submit a full resume with your application materials.

The Law and Government Scholars Program provides 10 credits, which, for the 2005-2006 academic year, is the equivalent of US \$12,020, in tuition support for one academic year. The award will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters only. Three Law and Government Scholars can be chosen for entrance each fall.

Special note to international applicants: The Law and Government Program can grant these scholarships only to students who are eligible to receive an I-20 from the university and who maintain legal immigration status as an F-1 visa holder. In order to receive the I-20, students must submit the Personal and Immigration Information Request Form (PIIRF) with this application. You must be able to demonstrate that you can support the remainder of the cost of the LL.M. program. Applications must be submitted with your LL.M. application and accompanied by the PIIRF form.
