

CORRECTIONS TO AND CLARIFICATIONS OF
THE WECHSLER 2009 COMPETITION RULES AND PROBLEM

1. The e-mail address for the Burton D. Wechsler First Amendment Moot Court Competition is firstamendment.wcl@gmail.com. The e-mail address listed in Wechsler 2009 Competition Rule IV(12) is incorrect.
2. Teams that wish to begin oral argument practice with non-Team Members prior to the deadline for submission of briefs must submit their final briefs before doing so.
3. Briefs should follow the format used by the United States Supreme Court. The required sections of the brief are limited to those listed in Wechsler 2009 Competition Rules IV(3)(a)-(i).
4. All citations to the Wechsler 2009 Problem should be cited as follows:

“(J.A. at **.)”

This includes all portions of the Problem (pp. 1-33).

5. Team Numbers should appear on the Cover Page of each brief submitted. It is not necessary to include Team Numbers in the margins of every page. It is not necessary to include “P” for Petitioner or “R” for Respondent.
6. The Wechsler Competition is an open competition. Outside research is encouraged.
7. For Teams with three competitors, all three Team Members must share equally in brief-writing responsibilities. The third Team Member may share equally in oral advocacy responsibilities, or serve as an alternate. If the third Team Member will serve as an alternate, that Team Member is not required to attend the Competition.
8. Kyle Broflovski is not a plaintiff for purposes of the Problem. Paragraph two of page eight of the Problem should begin: “On January 16, Cartman filed a motion in opposition to Broflovski’s motion to compel discovery”
