Professor Davey recently retired from the University of Illinois where he taught courses in International Trade law, European Union Law and International Business Transactions. Following his time as the legal advisor to the WTO, Professor Davey served on arbitral panels of international trade disputes between Canada and Brazil, the European Union and Korea and the European Union and the United States. Professor Davey has authored numerous textbooks and articles on international trade law issues. **Professor Davey was the WTO Legal Advisor from 1995-1999.**

Professor Steger serves as an Associate Professor at the University of Ottawa and is a leading authority on international trade policy and law. Professor Steger served as a senior negotiator for Canada during the Uruguay round of trade negotiations and served as the general counsel to the Canadian International Trade Tribunal during the implementation of NAFTA and the Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization. Professor Steger is a member of the Editorial Advisory board of the Journal of International Economic Law and Serves on the Board of Advisors to the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development. **Professor Steger was Director of the WTO Appellate Body Secretariat from 1995-2001.**

Professor Van den Bossche, is a professor of International Economic Law and the Head of the Department of International and European Law and Academic Director of the Institute for Globalization and International Regulation at Maastricht University. As a foremost authority on WTO law, Professor Van den Bossche has acted as a consultant to the European Commission, the Netherlands Ministry on Foreign Affairs, the United States Agency for International Development, the WTO and the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development. Professor Van Den Bossche also serves as a member of the Editorial Advisory Board of the Journal of International Economic Law and is the Author of The Law and Policy of the World Trade Organization Casebook. **Professor Van den Bossche was Counselor at the Appellate Body Secretariat of the WTO from 1995-2001 and Acting Director of the WTO Appellate Body Secretariat in 2001.**
