Submission of this form to the AUWCL Financial Aid Office constitutes a request for a cost of attendance increase for the application fees to take the Bar Exam and is governed by the following conditions.

- The COA increase is a one-time adjustment during the final year of your JD program. • While the cost of the Bar examination itself can be included in the cost of attendance, most other expenses associated with the Bar examination including bar prep courses and summer living expenses are not included.
- The COA adjustment results in increased loan eligibility and requires additional borrowing • to cover the cost. Note: Direct PLUS and private loans are subject to lender discretion and based on creditworthiness. (The AUWCL Financial Aid Office is not responsible for the expense if funding is denied.)
- Eligibility is limited to the term in which the purchase is made.
- The approved amount is disbursed in the term the request is made and will result in an unequal distribution of loan funds for the academic year.
- The allowance is limited to the actual cost for bar examination in DC as outlined below. If • you will be taking the exam in an alternate location, please complete the chart below and provide documentation supporting your actual costs.
