



UNITED METHODIST GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The **United Methodist Graduate Scholarship** is awarded each academic year to full-time graduate and law students enrolled at American University, who are full members of the United Methodist Church **for at least one year prior to application**. U.S. citizenship or permanent resident status is not required to apply for this scholarship. International students from one of the United Methodist Church Central Conferences must be a member of The United Methodist Church for a minimum of three years. International students from an autonomous Methodist Church (or non-UMC Central Conference) must have been a member of The United Methodist Church within the U.S. for at least three years. The scholarship is applied to tuition charges only.

For U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens, a **2023-2024 FAFSA** must be on file with the A UWCL Financial Aid Office.

Submit your application electronically to the A UWCL Financial Aid Office by August 11, 2023.
