

UNITED METHODIST GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The United Methodist Graduate Scholarship is awarded each academic year to full-time graduate and law students enrolled at American University, who are full members of the United Methodist Church for at least one year prior to application. U.S. citizenship or permanent resident status is not required to apply for this scholarship. International students from one of the United Methodist Church Central Conferences must be a member of The United Methodist Church for a minimum of three years. International students from an autonomous Methodist Church (or non-UMC Central Conference) must have been a member of The United Methodist Church within the U.S. for at least three years. The scholarship is applied to tuition charges only. For U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens, a 2024-2025 FAFSA must be on file with the AUWCL Financial Aid Office.
